Berta's paintings explore themes such as the ebb and flow of memory, the significance of personal heritage, the passing of physical time, desire,

grief, and love. Her Hungarian heritage pushes through in the joyful use of traditional clothing colors and the predominant theme of water and its natural healing properties. Often including reminders of her travels, her abstract works express unexpected sequences of patterns as well as distortion of perspectives and subconscious spaces.



Manipulating the canvas with several layers of texture paste, mixed media and acrylic paint, Berta will work and re-work her canvas' dimensions. Through her creative practice, she has found healing. Berta extends this blessing by offering to her community safe spaces for troubled teens and women to heal through the meditative process of painting.
