



LAURENCE DE VALMY

French American artist Laurence de Valmy is known for her distinctive style of repainting famous artworks by combining physical and digital mediums. Her artistic approach sheds new light on prominent art pieces and artists, and encourages viewers to reflect on current societal issues, such as the role of women, fame, and social media.

Drawing inspiration from the personal stories of renowned artists, Valmy employs the notion of time to create anachronistic paintings and videos that pay homage to the aesthetics of Instagram and TikTok. Among her notable works are the POST paintings, which exhibit skillfully appropriated iconic



artworks accompanied by imagined Instagram conversations that are historically accurate yet humorous.



Valmy's unique artistic style and innovative approach have garnered critical acclaim and recognition in the art world. Her artworks seamlessly blend the past and present, inviting viewers to reflect on the ever-changing nature of society and the central role of art in shaping it.

Currently residing in San Diego, USA, de Valmy's artwork has been exhibited nationally and internationally as well as shown in many private and public collections. De Valmy has received numerous awards and commissions.
