With an emphasis on geometry and color within his artworks, British artist Paul Westacott takes inspiration from the sunny California landscape to create his abstract paintings. The exploration of visual relationships is fundamental to Westacott's work. The dialogue between color, form, line, and repetition are the vocabulary that explore these relationships.



“For me, the joy and challenge of abstract art lies in the exploration and discovery of open-ended relationships. I hope to make art that ask questions rather than provides answers, inviting a multidimensional response with no 'right' or 'wrong' interpretation. Allowing the viewer to have their own subjective relationship with the work




based on their own unique passions, tastes, perceptions and experience.”


