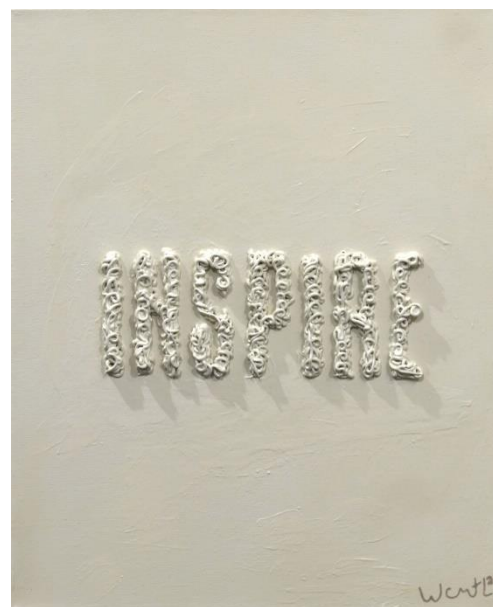
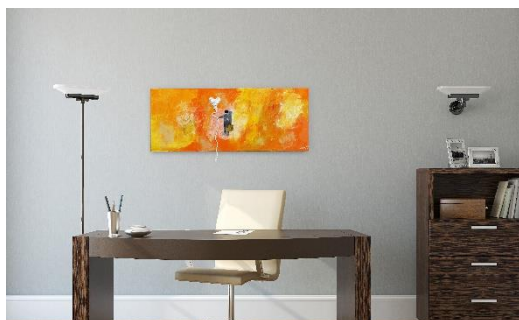
To create his signature texture, Raojenina uses a secret combination of acrylic paint and mixed media which he meticulously builds up layer after layer.
